

Small Groups and Bible Studies in the United Benefice

Small groups and Bible studies play an important part in the life of our benefice, allowing people to learn, worship and pray together, as well as to grow stronger friendships and offer and receive practical care.

We try to provide a wide choice in the groups we run:

Christian Basics – a straightforward introduction to what Christians believe, run over six sessions and assuming no prior knowledge of the church or Christianity. A great chance to ask questions or to refresh what you think you've believed for years. The course usually takes place in someone's home, features plenty of cakes and coffee and is led by our Rector, David Payne.

Bible Studies – our Bible studies now tend to run as short series dealing with particular topics. In the last twelve months these have included the God of the Old Testament, practical evangelism, Living the Lord's Prayer and living life under pressure. We are always open to suggestions for subjects to consider.

Home Groups – we have a number of home groups who meet regularly, including one for women and one dedicated to exploring creative ways of prayer. We hope to set up at least one new group in the next six months. You can try any of our groups out on a no-obligation basis!
