17	Loose stone	<i>A loose stone leaning on No 18. No name given, only some words of tribute to an unknown person. "Remember me / People must D[ie] ..."</i> / [Stone badly damaged by falling tree limb summer 2008, stone cut off and fragments removed]
18	Headstone	<i>Badly flaking and cracked. S(acred) / to the m(emory of) / Ch(ar)l(es?) / (3 lines flaked) / (w)ife? / Decem (ber) / aged 71 / (4 lines of verse illegible). [PR: gives nobody named Charles ----- in burial register 1730 – 1812 dying in December. Could perhaps be Charles WEBBEY buried November 1812] /</i>
19	Headstone	Here lieth Thomas / ye son of Joseph and / Julian LEAVES who dy'd / Aug ye 1?, 1736, in ye 24 / year of his age / (4 lines of verses) [PR: buried 8 August 1736] /
20	Headstone	Sacred / to the memory of / Edward, hus[ban]d of M----- / who departed this life January 10, 1810? / aged 61 years. Mary his wife died / October the 9 th ? 1820? (or 1826?) aged 71 years / (4 lines of verses) [PR: clearly the first of these is Edward PURCHASE, buried 20 January 1810. However, no burial identified in surviving BTs for the second person, 1820 – 1829] /

53	White Marble Wall Plaque (above No 52)	In memory of Henry HELYAR / Clerk in holy orders / 49 years Rector of Pendomer / born 1815. Fell asleep 1905 /
54	Stone inset in wall on south side of the altar	Here lies the body of / James UPTON of Yeovil / Gent who departed this / life August the 26 th 1784 / aged 54 years /
55	White Marble Wall Plaque (with arms, above No 54)	Near this place lieth / ye body of Thomas / TAYLOR, 37 years / Rector of this p'ish / who died ye / 12 th of / November 1720 / aged 66 years /

57	Inscription in glass panel in south window at western end of Nave	These windows & the roofs restored in / 1981 in memory of Ernest Richard / & Frances Mary SANDIFORD /
		In addition, there is in the Nave a stone recumbent effigy of a Knight in alcove in north wall, and parts of a mediaeval coffin inscription filling a doorway, now blocked up, in south wall. No legible inscriptions for either.
