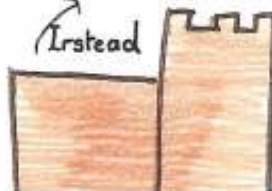

DRAGON TRAIL

How many dragons can you find?
Discover the story of the Ludham Worm

Visit

· St Michael, Irstead, NR12 8XS
Accessible by road and boat, adjacent to the River Ant

There are two “dragons” here—where are they?

· St Benedict , Horning, NR12 8PZ
Accessible by road, signposted off the A1062 just before Upper Street, Horning, and by boat on the River Bure

How many carvings of the Ludham Worm can you find?

· St Benet’s Abbey, nr Horning, Grid Ref TG383 157
Accessible by road—turn right off the A1062 after Ludham Bridge, driving from Horning and Ludham

The Ludham Worm hid under the vaults here—where do you think they were?

· St Catherine, Ludham, NR29 5AB
Accessible by road, bus and by boat, close to Womack Water

Legend has it that a hideous dragon terrorised the good people of Ludham and had its lair in the church. Can you find a carving of the Ludham Worm, or the hole where it escaped into the village?

All churches are open during daylight hours and the ruins of St Benet’s Abbey are always accessible,
