GOOD NEWS – THE STEEPLE IS NOW FULLY REPAIRED

You will have seen the scaffolding disappear from the steeple last November



when the exterior work was finished. Now the inside has been finished too and the steeple is once again ready for use. After all your help supporting the fund-raising to make the work possible, we would like to invite you to come and learn to ring the bells, or if you already can to come and ring with us. Now that it is safe to do so, we will be practising from September on Wednesdays between 7.00 – 9.00pm – the first part of the practice with the bell clappers tied to allow learners to make a start without annoying those of you who live very close.

If you are at all interested in learning the art of bell-ringing and helping ring for services, there will be an open tower afternoon on Saturday 10th. September between 2.00 and 4.00 pm when ringers will be there to ring the bells and you can see what actually goes on in the tower.

Ringers' ages range from 8 to 80 and you don't have to be really strong as the bells are mounted on roller bearings these days. Expert tuition is offered and once you can ring you will be welcomed by other ringers in any tower throughout the land and a few abroad.
