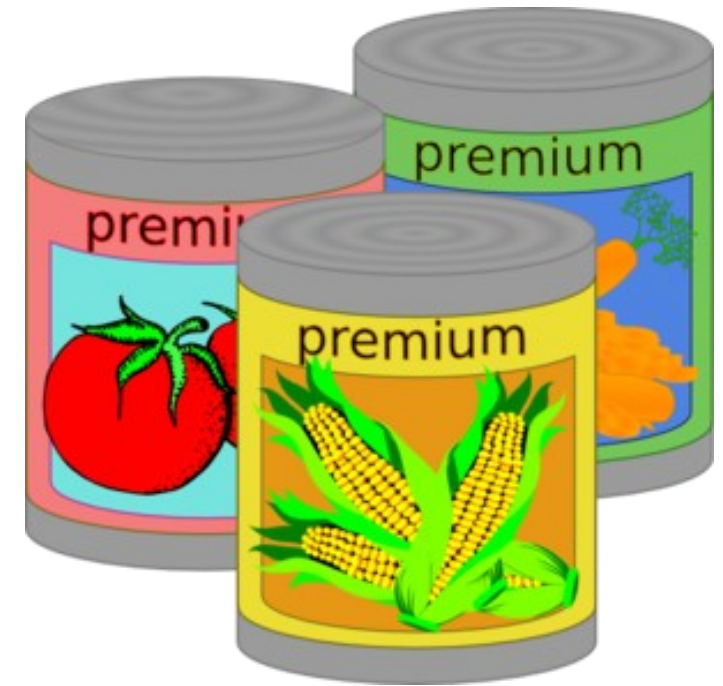


Windsor Foodshare

We are collecting food items for Windsor Foodshare. Food collected will be distributed to local families—could you please bring non perishable items only, from the following list:

- Tinned meat/fish
- Tinned vegetables
- Tinned tomatoes
- Soup
- Cooking sauces
- Herbs/Spices
- Breakfast cereals
- Instant coffee/Tea bags
- Sugar
- UHT Milk
- Rice
- Instant mash
- Tinned desserts
- Biscuits/Snack Bars
- Jams
- Fruit juice



The purpose of a food bank is to provide three days of supplies to those who do not have enough resources to buy food e.g. when the breadwinner has left the house or before benefit payments are received. Vouchers are issued by different agencies so that food can be collected from appointed collection points. The scheme for Windsor would eventually include distribution points in Dedworth, New Windsor and Old Windsor. It is hoped that 'Windsor Foodshare' would begin in a small way in Dedworth in mid-October, providing food for up to five families, under the auspices of Churches Together in Windsor and using the system already in place in Maidenhead.
