Godparents...

What is a Godparent?

The involvement of godparents can be one of the most joyful parts of the christening.

Godparents are not necessarily the people who will care for your child should anything happen to you. Rather they should be people who will be there for your child and help them think about the bigger questions in life - questions of love, hope and faith.

Godparents make the same promises on behalf of the child being baptised as parents.

Godparents promise to pray and support the child and to help the parents to bring up the child in the Christian faith.

It is an important and responsible role.

How many Godparents should I have?

Every child should have no fewer than three godparents, at least two of the same sex as the child. Parents may be godparents for their own children, providing they have at least one other godparent, but we would encourage you to choose family members or friends for this important role.

Who should I choose to be a Godparent?

Godparents can be family members or friends. However, it is important that you choose people who will take an interest in your child's spiritual welfare and who will pray for you and your child.

Godparents must be baptised themselves and old enough to make some serious promises on behalf of the child, which is why we ask that they be aged over 16 years.

It is a good thing if you can find Godparents that have a Church connection.
